Shirley Sarno of the Sonora Chamber said one of the light globes was missing from a lamp post in Courthouse Park.

Committee Member Williams said that several years ago while walking downtown they avoided going through Courthouse Park, but now after the landscaping renovations it has a whole new atmosphere and has become a wonderful asset to downtown Sonora.

Committee Member Kellogg stated that the Soroptomists have confirmed they will cover all costs associated with the Coffill Park benches. They will work with public works for the plaques.

Committee Member Williams thanked everyone for their involvement and reminded everyone the next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, July 28th at 9:00 a.m. The meeting was adjourned at 10:30 a.m.
