NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Sonora, State of California, will receive bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, equipment, transportation and services for the construction of:

Greenley Road/Mono Way Intersection Project – Phase 2

The project consists of: the street improvements for the Greenley Road/Mono Way intersection, including widening of the north side of Mono Way and the east side of Greenley Road, and includes associated traffic management, grading, drainage, concrete sidewalk work, base and asphalt paving, striping, wet utility relocations, signal system modifications, and other miscellaneous and offsite work indicated by the plans and specifications.

Each bid is to be in strict accordance with the Project Plans and Specifications (hereinafter called the "Proposal Requirements") on file at the City Administration Office, 94 North Washington Street, Sonora, California.

Proposal Requirements may be examined at the said Administration Office and copies may be obtained:

Mono Way, Sonora, CA 95370, (209) 532-5223 at a cost of: \$45.00 for one set of Proposal Requirements which includes one set of reduced plans (11"X17"), a Specifications booklet, and a separate Proposal (Bid) Form, plus shipping where necessary. Full sized plans (24"X36"), additional reduced plans, and a CD with digital pdf files of the Proposal Requirements with plan files are available to purchasers of one full set of Proposal Requirements at the following costs, plus shipping where necessary: \$32.00 per set of full sized plans, \$12.00 per set of reduced plans, and \$5.00 for a CD with digital pdf files of the Proposal Requirements with plan files.

No bid will be considered unless it is made on the paper proposal form furnished by the City with the Proposal Requirements. Each bid must be accompanied by cash, a certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond made payable to the City of Sonora for an amount equal to at least ten percent (10%) of the amount bid, such guarantee to be forfeited should the bidder to whom the contract is awarded fail to furnish the required bonds and enter into a contract with the City within the time provided by the Proposal Requirements.

Bid proposals shall be submitted to the City Administration Office on or before 2:00 P.M. on the 7th day of June, 2017 and will be opened in public at 2:00 P.M. on that day in the City Administration Conference Room, 94 North Washington Street, Sonora, California, and then and there read and recorded. Any bid received after the time specified herein will be returned to the bidder unopened.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish a Faithful Performance Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price and a Payment Bond in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract price.

No bid will be accepted from a Contractor who is not licensed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9 of Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code.

This project is a "public works" project under Section 1720 of California Labor Code and the Provisions of Section 1720 through 1861 of the California Labor Code shall apply. This project is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the California Department of Industrial Relations (DIR).


All contractors and subcontractors who bid or work on this project must be currently registered with the DIR under Section 1725.5 of the California Labor Code, and will be required to furnish electronic certified payroll records to the Labor Commissioner (aka Division of Labor Standards Enforcement) as required by the Labor Commissioner under Section 1776 of the California Labor Code.

In accordance with the provisions of Sections 1770 to 1780 of the Labor Code, the Director of Industrial Relations, State of California, has determined the general prevailing rate of per diem wages in the locality in which the work is required to be performed for each type of worker or mechanic required to execute the contract. The Contractor to whom the contract is awarded, and any subcontractor under it, shall pay not less than the general prevailing rate of per diem wages to all workers in execution of the contract.

The particular attention of bidders is directed to the provisions of Section III, Subsection 15 (Fair Employment Practices) of the Proposal Requirements which concerns affirmative action requirements.

The City of Sonora reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive any informality or irregularity in the bidding.

Project Information:

1. There is no scheduled Pre-Bid Conference on the project.
2. Estimated bid range of the project is in the order of \$700,000 to \$900,000.
3. One Alternative Bid Items is included in the Proposal Requirements which may be elected by the City. Determination of the Low Bidder will be made on the basis of the Total Base Bid, regardless of Alternate Item bids.
4. The Bidding Contractor must have California Class A Contractors License. Specialty work not under Class A Contractor work by California Contractor Licensing Law, shall be performed by a contractor licensed in the specialty class of the work.
5. Bidders must submit bids on the paper forms included in the Proposal Requirements. Bid Bonds submitted with bids shall be original documents.
