Cases For discussion:

On June 11, 2017, around 12:13 A.M., Sonora Police Officers were dispatched to Walmart (1101 Sanguinetti Road) for a report of two intoxicated males causing a disturbance and attempting to steal merchandise. Officers arrived on scene and located one of the male subjects in the parking lot. An officer contacted the male subject, identified as Paul Ryan Bristow, 33 years old of Eureka. During a search of his person, the officer located a small amount of methamphetamine and merchandise later determined to be stolen from Walmart. Officers also entered Walmart and located the other subject, who was identified as Manuel Wesley Taylor, 30 years old of Sonora. During a search of Taylor officers located stolen merchandise belonging to Walmart as well as a fixed bladed knife, which was concealed in Taylor's waistband. After conducting an investigation, officers determined that Taylor had furnished Bristow with the methamphetamine. Taylor and Bristow were transported to the Tuolumne County Jail and charged with theft. In addition, Taylor was booked for possession of a concealed dirk or dagger and furnishing a controlled substance, both felony crimes.

On June 5, 2017, about 11:01A.M., Sonora Police Officers responded to an injury vehicle vs. bicycle collision at the intersection of S. Washington Street and W. Stockton Street (SR 49). Officers determined a 10-year old boy was riding his BMX style bicycle near the southwest corner of that intersection. At the same time, a Sheriff's Community Service, 2013 Chevy pickup was stopped at the intersection facing eastbound preparing to turn right onto southbound S. Washington Street. At some point, both the bicyclist and pick up began their forward movement, resulting in a collision which knocked the boy to the ground; partially pinning him underneath the front of the pickup. Emergency crews were able to quickly free the boy and begin first-aid measures. Thankfully, the boy's injuries were not life-threatening, but medical personnel on scene made a decision to have him transported to a trauma center due to injuries he received to his left foot.

Recruitments:

- Ashley Brandow, who was previously hired for our Police Officer Recruit position, is attending the Delta College Police Academy.
- Tyler Oliver was recently selected for one of our Entry Level Police Officer positions and is currently in the background phase of his hiring process.

Field Training Program:

- Officer Corey Dufour is the only officer currently going through the department's field training program. He is currently being evaluated by Field

Training Officers John Bowly and Brandon Norris. Officer Dufour is progressing through the program.

Special Events/Community Presentations:

- On June 29th, Officer Brandon Norris participated in a community presentation at the Sonora Youth Center (732 S. Barretta Street). Officer Norris spoke with children about the job duties of a Police Officer and the various types of equipment we use.

NEIGHBORHOOD WATCH:

CASE(s) FOR DISCUSSION:

On June 11, 2017, at about 0132 hrs, Officer Durham was dispatched to the rear of Zanes Iron Horse Saloon for a report of an assault with a deadly weapon, A skateboard. Officer Durham was able to determine that a fight occurred between 28-year-old Canyon Fox and 28-year-old Travis Miller. Both subjects were intoxicated and got into an altercation. During the altercation, Miller was struck by Fox on the head with the skateboard causing injuries to Miller's face. The altercation was caught on video. Fox was later arrested at his residence in and booked into the County Jail on charges of 245(a)(1) PC.

On June 17, 2017, the Sonora Police Department Dispatch received a call of a structure fire on Truckenmiller Road off of Mono Way. Sonora City Fire, Cal Fire, Columbia Fire, Jamestown Fire, Twain Harte Fire and Tuolumne County Fire responded. When the first units arrived on scene a single story, abandoned house was fully engulfed and spreading to the wild land. The spread of the fire was quickly stopped and no other structures were damaged. Sonora Police Department along with Sonora City Fire determined the cause of the fire to suspicious. Arson is suspected in this fire by an unknown subject.

Range:

Training:

Officer Brandon Norris attended FTO School in Sacramento and is now qualified to have trainees with him and certify them for our training program.

Police Cadet Ashley Brandow finished week 4 of the 26 weeks intensive Police Academy at San Joaquin Delta Academy. She passed the slow speed EVOC test, the first aid test, and the Module III written test. Sunday the class will have their first range test. This course will earn her a basic training certificate through California's Commission of Peace Officer's Standards and Training (POST), making her eligible to work as a sworn Peace Officer in California.

Officer John Bowly and Sergeant Rogers attended an eight-hour crisis intervention course in Calaveras County. This course is now required by Peace Officer Standards and Training / State law, for all FTO personnel who train personnel to attend to keep current as a Field Training Officer.

Sgt Wertz, Vicky Chew and Deborah Dills all attended the CSJVRMA Body Camera Symposium. This was a 6 hour course on body worn camera issues and discussions.

Officer Hankins and Recruit Officer Dufour attended a NIMS class. This class was a local class which qualified them for Incident Command System 100 and 200.
