- Fire Captain** *(4 years of municipal firefighting experience within an organized fire agency, including 1 year of lead responsibility/At least 15 units at an approved college with course work in fire science, public administration or related field/At date of appointment, must possess a valid California Class B Drivers' License, including tank and air brake endorsements, and have a responsible driving record/Must be certified by the State of California as a Firefighter I/Must be currently certified as a State of California EMT, including a current AED/CPR Cert/Certified by the State of California as a Fire Officer within one year of appointment/Provide proof of having successfully complete Driver Operator 1A and 1B/Certified by the State of California for ICS I-300/Certified by FEMA for NIMS 700 and 800)*
- Fire Engineer** *(Graduation from high school or passage of the high school level General Education Development (GED) Test/Must also have a minimum of two years of current full time-paid municipal fire fighting experience with an organized fire agency or four years of current part-time or volunteer fire fighting experience with an organized fire agency or two (2) years current full-time experience in a qualifying Intern Program(s) and completion of a qualifying task book. Current experience is usually interpreted to mean full time experience obtained within the last two (2) years or part-time or volunteer experience obtained within the last four (4) years/Must possess a valid California Class C Drivers' License with a Fire Fighter endorsement, including Driver-Operator 1A or equivalent and within one (1) year of appointment, must possess a valid California Commercial Class A or B Driver's License with a tank endorsement, including Driver-Operator 1B or equivalent/Must be certified by the State of California as a Firefighter I/Must be currently certified as a State of California EMT, including a current AED/CPR cert/IS700 (NIMS) and IS800 (NFR) must be obtained within one (1) year of appointment)*
