1. Consideration of draft ordinances addressing property maintenance.

Chief New and Deputy City Attorney Goldstein reviewed the draft of Ordinance 835. Council and staff discussion ensued regarding public nuisances and existing laws; vehicle parking on unimproved lots to include other surfaces; outside storage of vehicles being repaired to consider covers; concerns with 30 day expired registration and inoperable door locks being a violation; and, the review and appeal process, hearing officer qualifications and Council appeals. Sergeant Hankins responded to questions by the Council. There were no comments when the Mayor asked for public comment.
